Although there are changes depending on the type of sexual problem and the problematic couple. Sexual treatments last for 2-4 months and 6-10 sessions on average. But there may be cases that can be resolved in a short time by one or two interviews. Or there may be cases where the treatment should last for one or two years.

Problematic sexual behavior (PSB) is more than kids playing doctor or showing curiosity about private parts. PSB involves sexual body parts and is outside of typical development. A clear indication of a problem is when the behaviors are aggressive, intrusive, or coercive, and there is harm to the youth and others.

Other treatment strategies include: Medication — When a medication is the cause of the dysfunction, a change in the medication may help. Be concerned if sexual behavior does not respond to parental intervention. 3: Sexual behavior that includes use of force, coercion, or aggression are highly concerning. Professional support is needed. 4: Boys and girls can have problematic sexual behavior. 5: Treatment can help prevent future problematic sexual behavior.

Various criteria for levels of intervention have been proposed regarding children with sexual behavior problems. Research suggests support for both cognitive behavioral and play therapy interventions. Therapists should use caution in adapting techniques developed for adults or adolescents because the same dynamics may not apply.

Identifying and treating early symptoms may help prevent compulsive sexual behavior from getting worse over time or escalating into a downward spiral of shame, relationship problems and harmful acts.
