Personally, any repeated effort to improve a student's reading and writing skills is a win in my book. However, her summaries were rough at first. Really rough. So I dusted off my teaching resources, updated a few things, and handed her this: the 1-hand summary. Here's the skinny. . . How to Teach Summary Writing-The 1-Hand Summary:

### Less is More? How to Teach Summary Writing

Dos in Writing a Chapter Summary. Before writing a chapter summary, you must first thoroughly understand what you have read. Read the material and take note of the of the highlights of the story. 1. Take note of the main theme. Ask the usual 5 Ws and 1 H questions - Who, What When, Where, Why and How.

### Dos and Don'ts in Writing a Chapter Summary | Examples

Summary writing is the act or the formal writing process of creating or making a conclusion using a few words to highlight the most important information of an essay, speech, or other address. It is done by choosing the most essential elements that the writer has stated in the main body or main dialogue and try to present it briefly once again at the last part.

For the student, it offers them a chance to synthesize what they just read and sort out the ideas in their own words. For the teacher, it is a great way to assess the student's comprehension of the material.
